Livingston presents at TTG Italia 2007 its flights schedule for Winter 2007/2008

- Opening of the Airport in Boavista (Cape Verde)
- **Milan Malpensa/San Salvador: weekly scheduled flight**
- **"All-business" connections to Maldives and Kenya**

Livingston, the Italian private carrier owned by Ventaglio Group and specialized in both scheduled and charter leisure flights, presents its flights schedule for the IATA Winter season 2007/2008 (28th October / 29th March). All connections are operated by the Airbus A330-200s (297 seats/business and economy class) and A321-200s (210 seats/economy class).

As to long-haul scheduled connections, the real piece of news is represented by the weekly, non-stop, connection between Milan Malpensa and **San Salvador (El Salvador)** operating from 21st October. Moreover, the winter schedule includes the long-haul rotations to the well-known destinations offered by the carrier, such as Brazil, which is connected to Italy through five weekly flights reaching the destinations Maceio, Fortaleza, Recife, Salvador de Bahia, Natal, **Porto Seguro** and **Rio de Janeiro**. As to the long-haul charter connections, after a two-year stop, the flights schedule introduces, once again, the connections to **Panama (Panama City)**, **Colombia (Cartagena)**, **Myanmar (Yangon)** and **Thailand (Phuket)** in co-operation with the Tour Operator Dimensione Turismo. With reference to the short/medium-haul charter connections, new routes have been introduced, namely from Milan Malpensa to **Senegal (Dakar)**, **Gambia (Banjul)** and **Portugal (Porto Santo)**.

OPENING OF THE AIRPORT IN BOAVISTA

The opening of the airport in Boavista, in the archipelago of Cape Verde, is taking place during the week from 26th to 31st October 2007. Starting from 20th December 2007, this wonderful island, situated in the Atlantic Ocean, will be reachable, from the airports of Milan Malpensa and Verona Villafranca, through two weekly non-stop flights operated by Livingston (without stop-over on the island of Sal). The Tour Operator, present on the flights, is I Viaggi del Ventaglio, which markets two tourist facilities located in Boavista - the VentaClub Boavista and the Marina Club – for a total of about 400 rooms.

Livingston flies "ALL BUSINESS" to Maldiv Islands and Kenya !!!

In co-operation with the partner Tour Operator Hotelplan, starting from 22nd December, an **"ALL-BUSINESS" weekly, scheduled flight (operated on Saturday) will connect Milan Malpensa to Male (Maldiv Islands)**, with a technical stop-over in Bahrain, both on the outbound and the inbound flights. The connection will be operated by a MD 83, leased by Livingston - on a wet-lease basis - from the French private airline Blue Line, specialized in all-business/VIPs flights. The cabin is equipped with 60 comfortable seats and the flight offers a superior onboard service, from catering to In-flight-Entertainment, plus the possibility of comprehensive customization, starting right from the passenger's arrival at the airport. Moreover, for the whole Christmas/New Year period, the same aircraft will operate some all-business rotations from Milan Malpensa to **Mombasa (Kenya)** with a technical stop-over in Luxor, both on the outbound and the inbound flights.
