**LIVINGSTON RANKS FIRST AMONG ITALIAN AIRLINE COMPANIES  
IN ALTROCONSUMO SURVEY**

- **2nd in Europe**
- **9th in the world**

Livingston SpA, the Italian leisure airline, offering both scheduled and charter flights and owned by the Ventaglio Group, ranks first among Italian carriers in the survey recently published by Altroconsumo, an independent consumers' association, involving over 8,600 European travellers (among them 1,500 Italians), aimed at polling satisfaction levels in terms of reliability, punctuality, in-flight services and customer care. Livingston SpA ranks 9<sup>th</sup> at world level (behind, in the following order, Emirates, Singapore Airlines, Malaysia Airlines, Sri Lanka Airlines, Qantas, Thai Airways, Luxair and China Airlines) and 2<sup>nd</sup> in Europe, preceded only by Luxair. The survey was conducted by Altroconsumo from September to November 2005, in collaboration with consumer associations from five other European Union countries (Spain, Netherlands, Belgium, Portugal and France) and the results involved 110 airline companies worldwide.

Livingston SpA also announces that in February 2006 its Dispatch Reliability was 100% for both models of aircraft in the fleet (Airbus A330-200 and Airbus A321-200). In the three-month period January-March 2006 the average stood at 99.5%, compared to a world average for the same type of aircraft of 99.1%.\*
